



As you may be aware between the 11th - 13th June the G7 summit is taking place in Cornwall and there is major disruption expected across the whole region due to this. From Monday 7th June preparations for the event and the arrival of delegates will begin and major restrictions will be in force. We have been informed that local and regional restrictions can and will be imposed and enforced at a moment's notice with no warning given, especially in areas where delegates will be residing which remains unknown to us at this point for obvious security reasons.
